INCIDENT DESCRIPTION	Officers responded to the East Village area of campus to help CMPD search for an individual involved in a shooting at a nearby convenience store. Sgt. Smith observed an individual matching the description outside of the Student Health Center board a CATS bus began following it. After following the bus off campus and waiting for an officer to assist, an investigatory stop was conducted and officers determined the person of interest was, in-fact, the suspect. The individual was detained and a loaded handgun was recovered. CMPD responded and placed the male under arrest. The suspect was not affiliated with UNC Charlotte and already had an active Trespass Order. He was issued a new Trespass Order and state citation for 2 nd degree trespass on scene. A warrant for felony possession of a gun on educational property was later obtained and would be served in jail. CMPD charged the subject with unlawfully carrying a concealed gun and may pursue other charges. The other shooters reportedly fled the scene in a vehicle and were not located.
