The individual was cooperative with UNCC Officers and was not disruptive. Dispatch contacted G4S/Allied Barton, and they responded within 15 mins. UNCC Officers stood by with the individual and Security till G4S/Allied Barton arrived and took the suspect into custody. An extended MI was completed.
